

But what saith it? True Light of Jesus Christ of Nazareth **STATEMENT OF FAITH**

The Bible is the inerrant,¹ verbally inspired Word of God, ² and is the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men. It constitutes the divine and sole authority of Christian faith and practice., ³

There is one God, ⁴ who is infinitely perfect, existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit., ⁵

Jesus Christ is true God , ⁶ and true man., ⁷ He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, ⁸ and born of the virgin Mary. ⁹ He died upon the cross,¹⁰ the just for the unjust, ¹¹ as a substitutionary sacrifice, and all who believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood. ¹² He arose bodily from the dead according to the Scriptures,¹³ and is now at the right hand of the Father, ¹⁴ in heaven,¹⁵ as our great High Priest.,¹⁶ He will come again to establish His kingdom of righteousness and peace.¹⁷

The Holy Spirit is a divine person,¹⁸ sent to regenerate, ¹⁹ indwell, ²⁰ guide, teach, ²¹ and empower the believer , ²² and to convict the world of sin, of righteousness, and of judgment. ²³

Man was originally created in the image and likeness of God; ²⁴ he fell through disobedience,²⁵ thereby incurring both physical and spiritual death.²⁶ All men are born with a sinful nature, ²⁷ are separated from the life of God, ²⁸ and can be saved only through the atoning work of the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth. ²⁹ The future of the unrepentant and un-believing is existence forever in conscious torment; ³⁰ and that of the believer, in everlasting joy and bliss. ³¹

Salvation has been provided through Jesus Christ of Nazareth for all men,³² but only those who repent ³³ and believe in Him,³⁴ are born again of the Holy Spirit,³⁵ receive the gift of eternal life ³⁶ and become the children of God.³⁷

It is the will of God that each believer should be continually filled with the Holy Spirit;³⁸ and be sanctified wholly, being separated from sin and the world and fully dedicated to the will of God, thereby receiving power for holy living and effective service. ³⁹ This is a progressive experience wrought in the life of the believer subsequent to conversion.

The church consists of all those who believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, are redeemed through His blood, and are born again of the Holy Spirit. ⁴⁰ Christ is the Head of the body,⁴¹ the Church, ⁴² which has been commissioned by Him to go into all the world as a witness, preaching the Gospel to all nations and making disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that Christ commanded. ⁴³ The local church is a body of believers in Christ who are joined together for the worship of God, for prayer, fellowship, the proclamation of the Gospel, and observance of the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper.⁴⁴

There shall be a bodily resurrection of the just and of the unjust; for the former, a resurrection unto life; ⁴⁵ for the latter, a resurrection unto judgment;⁴⁶ and the certain damnation of Satan, a personal being, fallen with his angels to perform evil under God's permissive sovereignty during this age.⁴⁷

The second coming of the Lord Jesus Christ is imminent. He will return bodily in the air to gather His Church to be with Him immediately prior to the Tribulation. This is the believer's blessed hope and is a vital truth which is an incentive to holy living and faithful service. ⁴⁸

The Word of God

We believe that the Word of God was the light of all people. The light shined in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it. And The Word of God was the source of life; the word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1-10). We believe that the Bible is the Word of God, fully inspired and without error in the original manuscripts, written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, and that it has supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct (2 Timothy 3:16,17; 2 Peter 1:20,21; Hebrews 4:12,13).

The Trinity

You were chosen according to the purpose of God the Father and were made a holy people by his Spirit, to obey Jesus Christ and be purified by his blood.

We believe that there is one living and true God, eternally existing in three persons, that these are equal in every divine perfection, and that they execute distinct but harmonious offices in the work of creation, providence (foresight and care) and redemption (Genesis 1:26; Matthew 3:13-17; 1 Peter 1:2; Deuteronomy 6:4; Titus 3:4-7).

God the Father

We believe in God, the Father, an infinite, personal spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power, and love. We believe that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of man, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ (Isaiah 57:15; Exodus 3:1-15; John 4:23,24; 1 John 1:5).

Jesus Christ of Nazareth

We believe that Jesus Christ of Nazareth is the light of the World, he said. I am the light of the world; Whoever follows me will have the light of life and will never walk in darkness. We believe in Jesus Christ, God's one and only Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe in His substitutionary atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension into heaven, perpetual intercession for His people, and personal visible return to earth (John 8 :13-15, Matthew 1:18; Acts 1:9; 1 Peter 3:18; 1 John 2:1,2; 1 Corinthians 15:4,5; 1 Thessalonians 4:16,17; Revelation 21:1-8).

The Holy Spirit

We believe in the Holy Spirit who came forth from the Father and Son to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgement, and to regenerate, sanctify, and empower all who believe in Jesus Christ. We believe that the Holy Spirit descended to indwell every believer in Jesus Christ of Nazareth and that He is an abiding helper, teacher, encouraged and guide (John 14:26; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8; John 16:7-15; Ephesians 5:18; Titus 3:4-6; Galatians 5:16-18, 22-25).

Regeneration

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; We believe that all people are sinners by nature and choice and are, therefore, under condemnation. We believe that those who repent of their sins and trust in Jesus Christ as Savior are regenerated by the Holy Spirit (Romans 3:23 -27; Acts 3:19 -23; John 3:36; Titus 3: 4-7).

The Church

We believe in the universal church, a living spiritual body of which Christ is the head and all regenerated persons are members. We believe in the local church, consisting of a company of believers in Jesus Christ, baptized after a credible profession of faith, and associated for worship, work, and fellowship. We believe that God has laid upon the members of the local church the primary task of giving the gospel of Jesus Christ to our lost world (1 Corinthians 12:13; Luke 10:27; Matthew 28:18 - 20; Ephesians 4:11 - 16).

Christian Conduct

We believe that Christians should live for the glory of God and the well - being of their fellow Christians, that their conduct should be blameless before the world, that they should be faithful stewards of their possessions, and that they should seek to realize for themselves and others the full stature of maturity in Christ (Philippians 1:27; 1 Peter 1:15,16; 1 Corinthians 4:2; Colossians 1:28,29; Matthew 25:14-30; 1 Corinthians 10:23-31; Hebrews 12:14).

The Ordinances

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ has committed two ordinances to the local church: Baptism and the Lord's Supper. We believe that Christian baptism is the immersion of a believer in water into the name of the triune God. We believe that the Lord's Supper was instituted by Christ for commemoration of His death. We believe that these two ordinances should be observed and administered until the return of the Lord Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 8:36-39; 1 Corinthians 11:17-34).

Religious Liberty

We believe that every person who receives Jesus Christ of Nazareth as his Lord and personal Savior has direct relationships with God and is responsible to God alone in all matters of faith.. We believe that each church is independent and must be free from interference by any ecclesiastical or political authority; therefore, Church and state must be kept separate, having different functions and each fulfilling its own duties (Romans 13:1-7).

Church Cooperation

We believe that local churches can best promote the cause of Jesus Christ by operations with one another in a denominational organization. Such an organization, whether a regional or district conference, exists and functions by the will of the churches. Cooperation in a conference is voluntary and may be terminated at any time. Church may likewise cooperate with inter - denominational fellowships on a voluntary basis.

The Last Things

We believe in the personal and visible return of the Lord Jesus Christ to earth and the establishment of His kingdom. We believe in the resurrection of the body, the final judgment, the eternal bliss of the righteous, and the endless suffering of the wicked (1 Corinthians 15:4,5; Hebrews 9:27; Revelation 21 .1- 8)
